Thank you for your correspondence of 6 April 2020 about engagement of temporary agricultural workers to the Hon Darren Chester MP, Minister for Veteran's Affairs and Defence Personnel. Your letter has been referred to the Hon David Littleproud, Minister for Agriculture, Drought and Emergency Management as this matter falls within his portfolio responsibilities. Minister Littleproud has asked me to respond on his behalf.

Minister Littleproud is meeting with state and territory agriculture ministers across the country to manage the impact of measures implemented to address COVID-19 on the agriculture, fisheries, forestry and fibre sectors. This includes consideration of the potential impact on labour supply and people movement as a result of border closures, and how these can be managed in part, with the extension of Working Holiday Maker visas.

The Government is committed to protecting the health of Australians, supporting businesses and jobs and securing our food supply chain while we combat COVID-19. The Government has now implemented temporary visa measures to support the agricultural workforce needed to secure Australia's food supplies. State and territory governments have key responsibilities for self-isolation and social distancing requirements and, through National Cabinet, we are working with state and territory governments to implement complementary measures. All visa holders must meet all current state and territory requirements including self-isolation, social distancing, hygiene and appropriate accommodation.
